## Austin Alumni Chapter Community Projects:

### **Tutorial Programs in Math & Science:**

During the school year, members are encouraged to tutor students in area NSBE Jr. Chapters. Established in 1991.

### **Project FreshStart:**

Our outreach program that targets youth, grades 6 - 12, in order to expose them to a FreshStart in developing learning skills through interaction between engineering / science professionals. Established in 1992.

### **Mentoring Program:**

During the school year, members are encouraged to participate as mentors with our NSBE student counterparts.

### **Scholarship Competition:**

An annual competition for graduating high school seniors and our supported NSBE student chapters. Student selections are based on sub-committee review of applications which include an essay, academic achievements and community service.

### **Math & Science Activities:**

AA-NSBE hosts the Austin Area Try-Math-A-Lon Competition which sends participants to Regionals with hopes to compete at Nationals. The competition is Jeopardy style where high school students answer math, science and Black history related questions. We also participate in National Engineers Week where we sponsor teams to visit at local high schools.
